
Quickly get into your house or shelter.




2. Shut all doors and windows.

Tape and seal all windows and doors.




5. Place damp towels under doors to absorb gases.




6. Keep everyone in a room that has the fewest windows and doors.




Keep your phone charged and ready.



8. Tune in to the T.V. or radio (89.5 FM) for further instructions.





EVACUATE - GO!

When an emergency occurs, local authorities may call for residents to evacuate. When ordered to evacuate, it is important to remember:

- Follow your family (or business) emergency plan. Know how to communicate with family members or co-workers. Have a phone contact list.
- Know where to get information about the emergency Reverse Alert Notification System,
 KLUX 89.5 FM radio, Information Line (361-826-4636), and local television stations.


