I. Call to Order, Welcome and Introductions: Joseph Cantu, Vice Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:33 a.m. Tony Perez provided the facility safety briefing for the attendees.

II. Acceptance of Minutes: May 6, 2025, minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Sharon Bailey Murphy and second by Roosevelt Shavers, to approve of the minutes as presented. Motion passed.

III. New Business/Old Business: Chief Wade has approved formation of an Ad Hoc Committee to coordinate messaging for the Regional Reverse Alert System.

IV. Upcoming Training in the Community/Conferences: Training opportunities for the community and first responders can be found at www.coastalbendcan.org and www.preparingtexas.org.

V. Coordinator's Report: Joanne Salge reviewed the activities of the LEPC since the May committee meeting. Let us know if you would like to host a sub-committee meeting. The LEPC continues to attend the CCCAC meetings, Port Security Working Group, and CPLEPC meetings. The LEPC hopes to post the part-time position soon.

VI. Subcommittee Reports:

1. Finance Subcommittee: Our expenditures for FY 24-25 are \$81,657.07 of the revised budget of \$136,409.99 @ 59.89%. The Reverse Alert fund has been expended at \$87,031.01 at 100%. Donations to the LEPC are currently \$119,250.00. The LEPC continues to be conservative in spending. The next Finance Committee meeting will be held on August 28, 2025, on Webex. A motion to approve the Finance Committee report was made by Joseph Cantu and second by William Thompson. Motion passed.
2. Risk Awareness Subcommittee: Sharon Bailey Murphy provided an update for the Risk Awareness Committee. The last meeting was held on May 22nd. The committee is meeting quarterly. The Reverse Alert numbers: 28,854 and Nixle at 6,693, total 35,547. There were 11 industry alerts in June. The contract is complete to include Aransas, Refugio, and San Patricio Counties in the system. We have not had any new requests for Shelter in Place kits. The next Risk Awareness meeting will be held on Thursday, August 28 at 11:30am at CCFD Administration.
3. Pipeline Damage Prevention Subcommittee: Randy Brock presented the update for the Pipeline Committee. They plan to host a workshop on September 25th at the FEMA Dome. There will be

information provided by TX 811, National Weather Service, Texas Railroad Commission, and OSHA. The event is free and open to any excavator. Randy Brock stated the number of line strikes is down about 50% this year and most incidents are due to failure to maintain clearance. The next meeting for the Pipeline Damage Prevention Committee is September 2, 2025, at 9:30am in the City EOC.

4. Emergency Response and Communications Subcommittee: Recent training events and drills were reviewed. More are scheduled for the coming months. Recent site visits were conducted at Air Liquide, FHR (former Rangeland site), and VLS Texas Molecular. The next Emergency Response and Communication meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 23, 2025, at 11:30 am hosted by Flint Hills Resources.

VII. Presentation: Cory Mottice, Warning Coordination Meteorologist, National Weather Service, provided information and projections for the current hurricane season. No significant rain in sight currently.
